The potential changes include each school district practitioner obtaining an individual Medicaid provider number, school districts providing board member personal information on your ODM application renewal, as well as restrictive rules for reimbursing health services for students. This meeting will include stakeholders from the legislature, school districts and professional associations. Our goal for the meeting is to obtain a common understanding and then work together to develop a solution that maintains the viability of this valuable program for schools while providing the framework to prevent fraudulent activity in the program.
